■ MAY / JUNE

► FINALIZE YOUR UNIVERSITY ADMISSION

- Proof of an acceptance letter from Jean Moulin Lyon 3 University (via the platforms: Etudes en France, Mon Master, Parcoursup, e-candidat, etc.)
- Proof of an email from the registrar's office of your faculty providing all the information for your enrollment
- Go to the website <https://cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr/> to pay the CVEC
- Complete administrative registration at the university through the registration portal

■ BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL

► ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

Check the expiration date of your passport/ID card. For certain procedures (Visa, housing assistance, etc.), you may need a copy of your birth certificate (translated and apostilled for some countries).

VISA

If you are an EU citizen, this process does not concern you.

- Start your visa application if you are not an EU citizen
- >>> Apply for a student visa

For students from countries with the «Études en France» procedure:
the student is guided for their visa application on the Campus France website

For students from countries that are not concerned with the «Études en France» procedure:
the student should consult the website of the embassy of their country of residence to follow the visa application procedure.

Advice: This process can take several months depending on the country, start it as soon as you receive your acceptance letter from Lyon 3. Once you arrive in France, you must validate your Visa online (only for long-stay visas VLS-TS): <https://administration-etrangers-en-france.interieur.gouv.fr/particuliers/#/>

BANKING PROCEDURES

.....

Check if your bank account and credit card can be used in France. Otherwise, you can open your bank account at any agency.

Three documents are needed to open a bank account:

- An ID;
- Proof of address;
- A certificate of enrollment or student card

While waiting for a permanent address, you can sometimes use the address of the international relations office of your institution.

Also, consider international online banks which are convenient for currency conversion and making euro transfers without fees (Revolut, N26, Boursorama...).

BOOK YOUR TICKETS

Check the start dates by consulting the calendar:

- By plane: Lyon St-Exupéry Airport (30 minutes from Lyon by shuttle).
Lyon is served by low-cost airlines like Easyjet.
- By train: Part-Dieu or Perrache stations (in the center of Lyon).
Tickets can be booked on the SNCF website.
- By bus: Flixbus or Blablacar, very affordable prices.

INSURANCE

.....

Certain insurances are mandatory in France:

⇒ HEALTH INSURANCE

- If you are an EU citizen, you can use your European Health Insurance Card valid for the duration of your mobility
- If you are a Quebec student, your RAMQ (Quebec Health Insurance Board) certificate is accepted in France.
- If you are not an EU citizen, you have the choice to either keep your private insurance if it is comprehensive, or to apply for social security affiliation at the nearest Primary Health Insurance Fund (CPAM) to your home for free.

⇒ HOME INSURANCE

Home insurance covers incidents or accidents such as fire, burglary, or water damage. Inquire with a bank, an insurance company, or directly with the private residence managing your accommodation.

⇒ CIVIL LIABILITY INSURANCE

Civil liability insurance covers bodily injuries or property damage you may cause to another person. Proof of this insurance will be required to obtain your student card and to participate in sports. Most of the time, civil liability insurance is included in home insurance. It is also possible to subscribe to private insurance in your country that is valid in France.

PHONE PROCEDURES

.....

Check if you can keep your plan in France or, once in France, visit an operator (Orange, SFR, Free...) to get a new number with a SIM card.

■ UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

► MOVING INTO HOUSING

If necessary, open a water and electricity account. Subscribe to an internet provider.

WATER

Consult electricity providers (EDF, Engie...).

WIFI

Contact an operator if you wish to subscribe to an internet box in your accommodation (Orange, SFR, Free...).

► HOUSING ASSISTANCE

As a student, you may be eligible for housing assistance (if you stay at least 8 months in your accommodation, see conditions on the CAF website):

This assistance is paid to you monthly; note that it takes about two months to receive it. This allowance is calculated based on the type of accommodation, rent, resources, and the student's personal situation. To benefit from CAF housing assistance, you will need a social security number on your health card provided by the CPAM (health insurance).
